## POLICY

### 1 RATIONALE AND PURPOSE

- 1.1 The Fremantle Rowing Club is committed to providing a safe and friendly atmosphere to facilitate all levels of rowing.
- 1.2 The Fremantle Rowing Club is committed to providing and maintaining quality facilities and equipment for all members.
- 1.3 This Policy aims to provide guidance on how private boat storage requests are assessed in a fair and equitable manner whilst balancing the needs of club equipment for all members.

### 2 POLICY GUIDELINES

- 2.1 A request for the storage of a private boat and/or equipment is to be made in writing to the President.
- 2.2 The request is to detail the reason for storage at the FRC boat shed and the duration of storage (eg: off season, annually etc).
- 2.3 The committee will assess and approve each application on a case by case basis based on (but not limited to) the following criteria; attendance at a National Regatta, State Selection trials, contribution to the club and storage space.
- 2.4 The boat to be stored shall be insured by the member.
- 2.5 A storage fee shall be set by the committee and may be varied by the Committee when Annual Fees are decided.
- 2.6 Storage will be for a 12 month period and will be paid with Annual Membership. The arrangement will be reviewed at the end of each membership year. The club reserves its right to terminate the storage arrangement at this time. The fee must be paid prior to the boat being stored at the club.

- 2.7 Fees for storage commenced during the membership year will be assessed on the same basis as for membership fees in accordance with the constitution cl 9(3).
- 2.8 The Committee reserves the right to waive the storage fee based on the applicant's contribution to the club e.g. being a BRO, allowing the boat to be used by other club members or undertaking a significant amount of volunteer work.
